LEAD LINE DIVISION 8/UNDER (CLAY RING)**

1. Lead line Walk* *Sponsor: Charlotte Harbor Properties, Inc.*
2. Lead Line Walk/Trot a few steps*
3. Lead Line off the lead*

Lead line w/t will be asked to trot a few steps in a straight line. Lead line off the lead, handler walks next to the child/horse without a lead. Child may be asked to halt or change direction. **Points to follow rider.*

All corners must be trotted. Horse/Rider combination must be different to enter Handy Hunter Division. **Points to follow horse.*

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW GROUNDS: I-75 EXIT 161 (Jones Loop Road) West on Jones Loop Road to Taylor Road. Right on Taylor to Airport Road. Right on Airport Road to Florida Avenue. Left on Florida Avenue. Show grounds on left - approximately 1/2 mile.

Open to riders jumping 2' and over. USEF Equitation Tests 1-8 may be performed at Judges discretion. Marshall & Sterling Class is for riders under the age of 18.

Fence heights are 2' for Small/Medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies.

58. Marshall & Sterling Bit O'Straw Hunter Classic 2'6"

Open to Novice children or adult riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into the M&S Children's Hunter Pony Classic or any class exceeding 2'9".

Classes 57 & 58 will each be run as a two-round classic whereas the top six riders from the first round are called back to jump the same course again. Scores from both rounds will be added together to determine the winner.

Warm-Up classes are not judged and are not eligible for Year-End Awards.

Marshall & Sterling Class is Not Eligible for PGHA Year-End Award. Additional fees apply.

*O/F Equitation riders need to stay within their fence height. They may not cross enter to a higher division. O/F Hunter riders cannot compete in a higher division with the same Horse/Rider combination. ***Exception - 2' eq/hunter riders may try the Marshall & Sterling class but shall not compete in the 2'3" or 2'6" & Above hunter or equitation division without moving up.*

RULES FOR ATTIRE

GR318 DRESS

It is the tradition of the competition ring that riders and drivers be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and horses be properly presented. It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Show committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Boots/shoes worn while riding anywhere on the competition grounds must have a distinguishable heel.

ATTIRE

Riders should wear coats of any tweed or Melton for hunting, breeches or jodhpurs and boots. Conservative colored protective headgear in accordance with GR318.3 is mandatory. Spurs, crops, or bats are optional. Judges may penalize contestants who do not conform. When management permits Hunter or Hunter Seat Equitation riders to ride without jackets, riders must wear traditional, short, or long sleeved riding shirts with chokers or ties (for men). **CHAPS ARE NOT PERMITTED. POLO SHIRTS ONLY PERMITTED IN JUMPER CLASSES 1-5.**
