O/F Equitation riders need to stay within their fence height. They may not cross enter to a higher division. O/F Hunter riders cannot compete in a higher division with the same Horse/Rider combination.

O/F Equitation/Hunter riders may ride in any and all Jumper classes regardless of height. Leadline, Walk and Walk/Trot riders are excluded from Jumper Classes.

RULES FOR ATTIRE

Boots/shoes worn while riding anywhere on the competition grounds must have a distinguishable heel.

ATTIRE

Conservative colored protective headgear in accordance with GR318.3 is mandatory for ALL classes and when riding anywhere on the show grounds. Properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Spurs, crops, or bats are optional. Judges may penalize contestants who do not conform. No tube tops, tank tops or, spaghetti strap shirts will be permitted under any circumstances while showing (including exhibition). Proper attire consists of the following:

All Hunter, Equitation and Jumper Classes: Polos are permitted in all classes, breeches and appropriate English boots. Horse must be using English tack. No Hackamore's permitted. Leg protection/bell boots only permitted in Jumper classes.

Leadline Classes: Rider must be in proper attire as stated above. Handler/walker must have on boots. Horse must be using English tack.
