PGHA does not offer Special Needs classes. Special Needs Exhibitors may show in the Walk Division provided that a "spotter" accompanies the exhibitor. Please contact the Hunter/Jumper Director prior to the show.

Warm-Up classes are not judged and are not eligible for Year-End Awards.

O/F Equitation riders need to stay within their fence height. They may not cross enter to a higher division. O/F Hunter riders cannot compete in a higher division with the same Horse/Rider combination.

Jumpers may ride at or below their level in Hunters/Equitation. Lead Line, Walk and Walk/Trot riders are excluded from Jumper Classes.

Any class with 10 or more riders will be split into sections and judged separately, however Year End awards will not be split.

***Open Schooling in Clay Ring until 8:45am. Grass Ring until 9:15am.
Schooling allowed during lunch break. USEF RULES TO APPLY.***

ATTIRE

Conservative colored protective headgear, properly fastened, in accordance with GR318.3 is mandatory for ALL classes and when riding anywhere on the show grounds. All Hunter, Equitation and Jumper Classes: Polo shirts are permitted in all classes, breeches and appropriate English boots. No tube tops, tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts will be permitted while showing (including exhibition). Horse must be using English tack. Lead Line Classes: Rider must be in proper attire as stated above. Handler/walker must have on boots.

No Hackamore's permitted with the exception of Jumper Classes.

Leg protection not permitted in Hunter or Clay Ring Divisions/Classes.

Ear pieces or any other communication devices, including phones, are strictly prohibited while showing.

Excessive coaching by trainers to their showing students in the ring may be penalized by the judge.

Any rider who falls off their horse during a class must immediately exit the ring or stand in the center in a flat class and will be disqualified. Any rider with 2 refusals will be disqualified and must ask permission from the judge for a 3rd. and final attempt.

All showing horses must meet a minimum body condition score of 4 as outlined in the Florida State 4-H Rulebook as follows: <https://animal.ifas.ufl.edu/youth/horse/documents/BCS/FL4H-BCS-rule.pdf>

Moderately thin slight ridge along back; faint outline of ribs discernible; tailhead prominence depends on conformation, but fat can be felt around it; point of hip not discernible; withers, shoulders, and neck not obviously thin.

For year end award eligibility, member must show at 50% plus 1 (one) judge/show in each class/division that member is competing in, horse must be nominated and volunteer hour requirement must be met.

Judges and/or PGHA Directors may penalize exhibitors who do not conform to these rules along with all PGHA 2024-2025 rules as stated in the Rules & Regulations.
